All steps can be done on your smartphone!

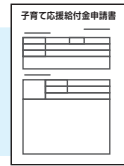
Before applying, please have the following documents ready and take clear photos of each full document in a bright place.



1 Documents every applicant must prepare

Aichi Prefecture Childcare Support Allowance Application Form (Electronically or on paper)



2

Entire page showing the Certificate of Birth Registration



3

Document showing that your child received their health checkup

The page in your Maternal and Child Health Handbook showing that your child received their 18-month or 3-year-old health checkup in a municipality in Aichi Prefecture



4

Document showing bank account information to receive the allowance

A bank passbook or cash card showing the bank name, branch name, account number, and account holder's name (in Katakana)

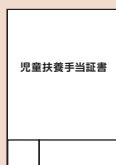


2 Additional documents required based on the previous page's flowchart (Type A or B)

Type A

If you receive the Child Rearing Allowance:

→ Document showing that you received the allowance for the month in which your child had their checkup



• A copy of the Child Rearing Allowance Certificate, etc.

Type B

If everyone in your household is exempt from paying Resident Tax:

→ Document showing that all persons listed on the certificate of residence are exempt from paying Resident Tax



• Certificate of residence listing all household members
• Tax exemption certificates or other documents of all household members aged 16 or over



Beware of payment scams and identity theft.

Aichi Prefecture or its contractor may contact you to ask about your application. However, they will never ask you to use an ATM or to transfer any fees to receive the allowance. If you receive any suspicious phone calls, please contact the Parenting Assistance Division or your nearest police station.
